**Points to Note:**

There must be no communication between students in writing, speech or gesture once they enter the examination room. **A student who resorts to any kind of malpractice during the examination will be awarded ZERO for that particular subject and will be suspended from appearing in the rest of the papers. NO request will be entertained for showing any leniency in such cases.**
4. **BRINGING MOBILE PHONES TO SCHOOL DURING THE EXAMINATIONS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED FOR ALL STUDENTS.**
5. As per the new examination guidelines issued by CBSE, possession of mobile phones, calculators, written material, books, notes etc. will be considered as an attempt to cheat and will result in strict action being taken against the erring student.
6. **Students must not write anything on the question paper except for their name and roll number. No Rough Work or calculation should be done on the question paper. Any violation of this rule will result in strict action.**
