


SUMMERTIME

Instructions for students:

- Do remember to complete the given tasks after reading them carefully. Try doing the activities independently. You may take the help of your elders if required.
- You may choose to do any 4 of the given activities of your choice.
- Creativity and originality of the work will be appreciated.
- Work should be done neatly on coloured A4 sheets.
- Compile and put your work in an attractive folder made by you using recycled material.
- Some tips to make this holiday special:
 - Have a family dinner every night during the holidays.
 - Play board games with your parents and siblings.
 - Spend some quality time with an elderly person in the family.

Activity 1: Money management

Managing money is an essential life skill that takes time and patience to master. Let's learn to inculcate basic money related concepts.


You are given ₹ 500 to spend as well as save for the future. Prepare a chart to show how you will spend the money given to you. You may mention bigger or smarter purchases where you used your negotiating skills. This will teach you financial responsibility and how to spend the money wisely. For example, ask yourself whether the object is for a 'need' or a 'want'. This will allow you to explain the idea that you have to prioritize what you spend money on, leaving some money for future necessities. An example is shown on the next page.

Activity 2: "The joy of Festivals brings us together".

Find out about 2 - 3 festivals celebrated across the world. Many festivals would be similar to those celebrated in India, for example- 'Makar Sankranti' in India is quite similar to the 'The Bermuda Kite Flying Festival' celebrated in Bermuda. Compare any one such festival using the Venn diagram given below to show the difference and similarities between them. Paste the Venn diagram on a coloured A-4 sheet after completing it.

Activity 3: Dance festivals across the world.

Gather information about a few popular dances around the world. On an A4 size sheet, present the following information you have collected, in a creative manner.

- Paste pictures of the dances across the world and write the name of the country.
- Mention the costume and jewellery worn by the performers.
- List the different instruments used to play the music for these dances (if any).
- Do not forget to write about the occasion on which these dances are performed (if any).

Follow-up activity will be done after the vacation where an intra-class competition will be organized for the students to showcase their talent. So, learn a few steps of any one such international dance. Bring along the music (pen-drive) on which you want to perform the dance. Wear the costume/jewellery accordingly.

Activity 4: My Pet Rocks-Rock!

Summer break is the time of the year when one spends the maximum quality time with their dear ones. With the help of your elders at home, wear your creative hats, pick up your paint brushes and get ready to have lots of fun. After the pet rocks are ready, on an A4 coloured sheet:

- describe the activity done by you
