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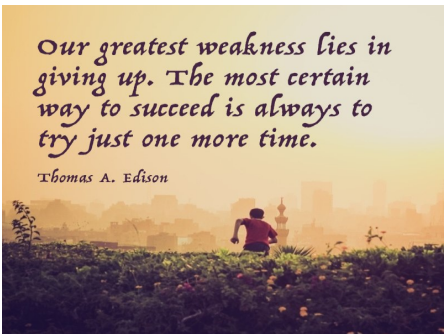

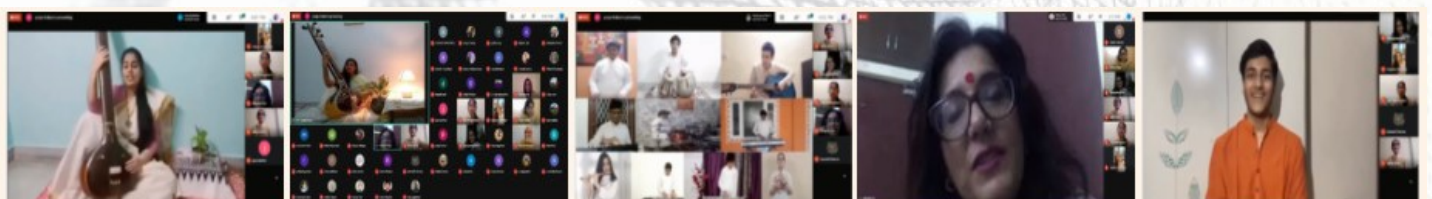
Gandhi Sandhya

United Nations Day Celebration



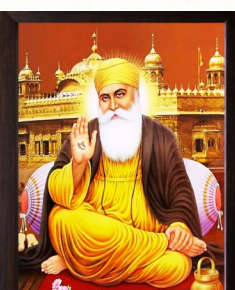
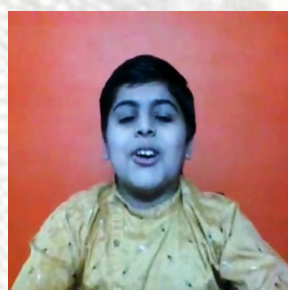

The Best School trophy was bagged by Indraprastha International School, Dwarka.

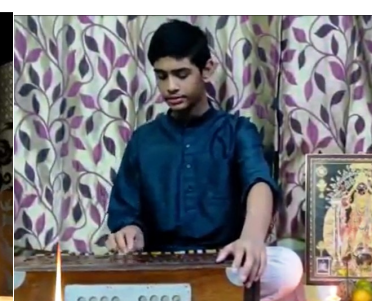
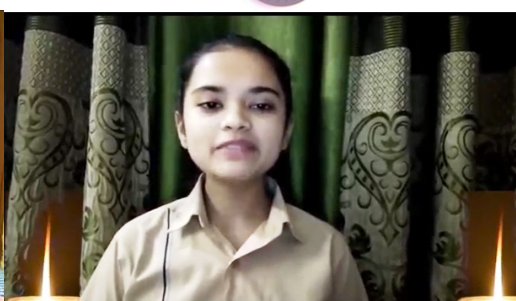
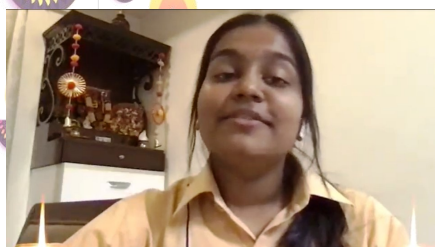

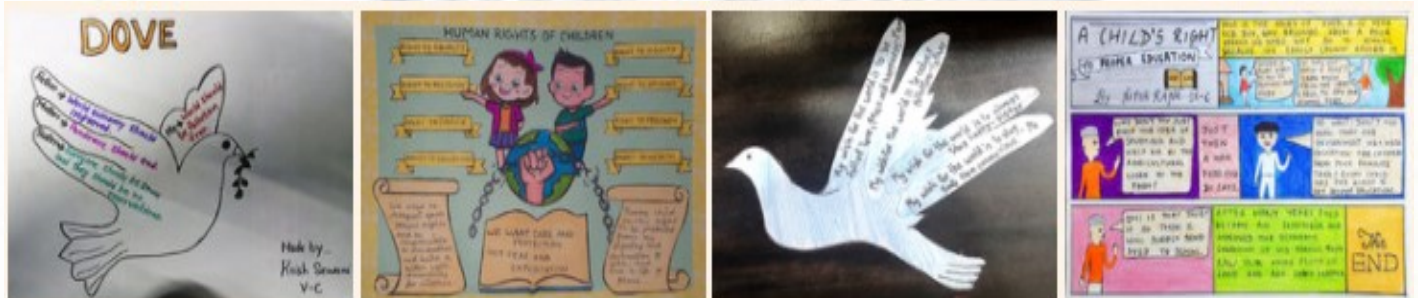
- 1) What is a constitution?

Students also did a group activity where they prepared graphic books on the topic: Preamble of the Indian Constitution. Each child participated in the activity enthusiastically.

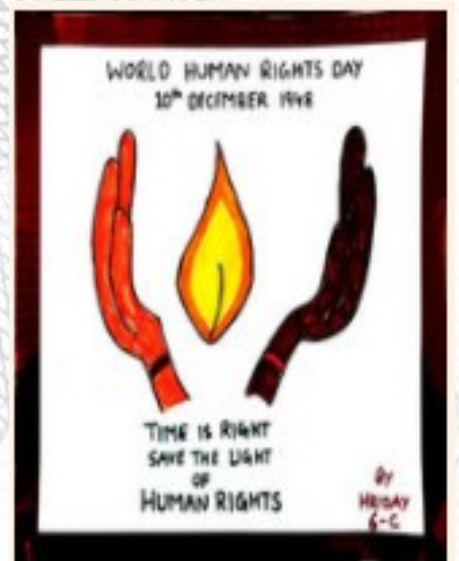
Students of class IX undertook a group activity where they researched a Constitutional Amendment of their choice and presented it in the class.

The Mathematics day was celebrated with the objective of creating awareness about the fact that mathematics permeates the world around us and also to appreciate its usefulness, power and beauty.

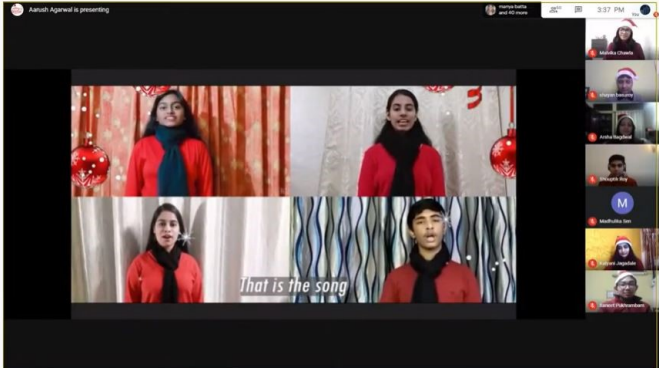
As a part of the celebration, a video made by our students depicting the journey, historical anecdotes and unknown amazing facts about the mathematical genius was shown to the students.

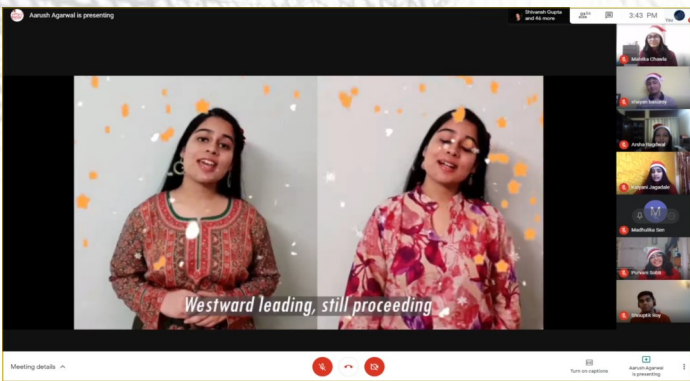
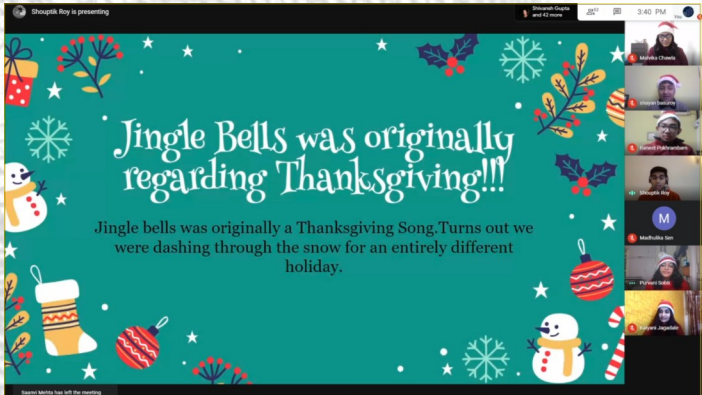
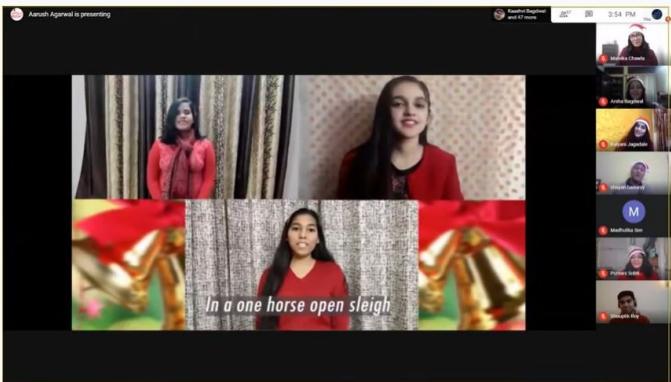
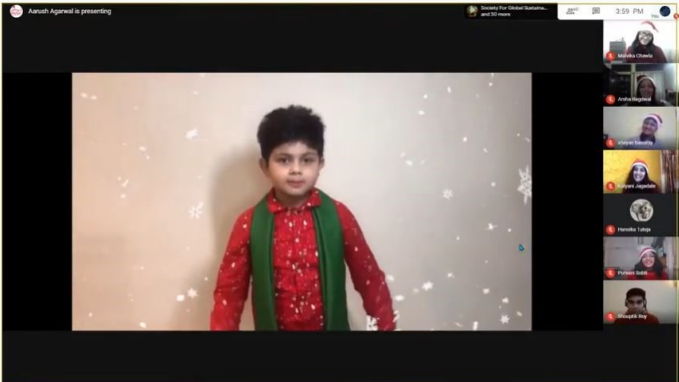
The students not only participated in the activities with great zeal and enthusiasm but also developed patience and persistence while answering and participating in the game show.

Virtual Sports Day

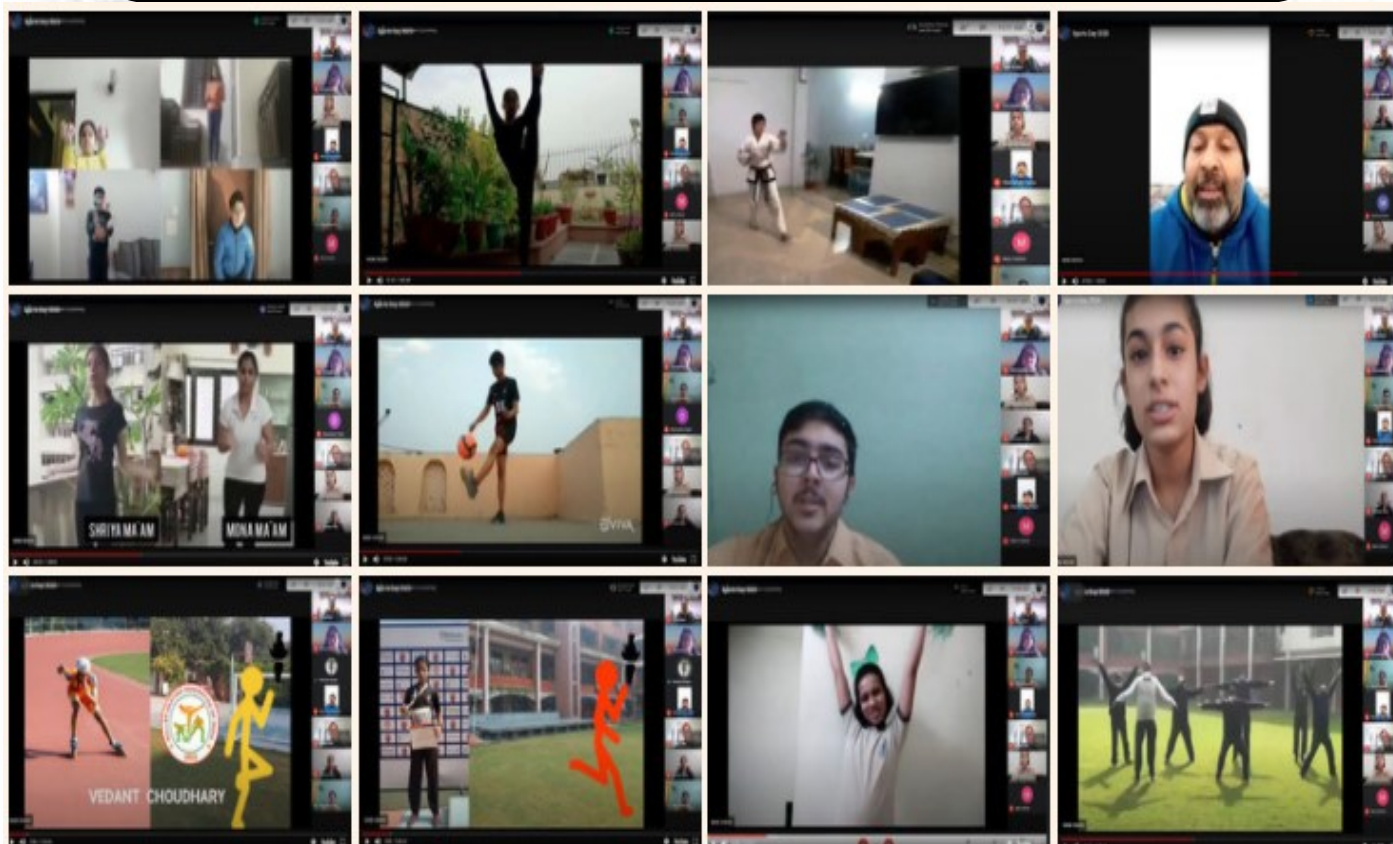

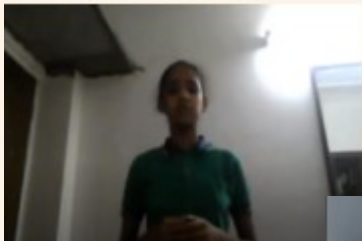
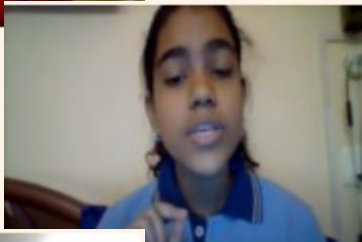
Inter House Competitions

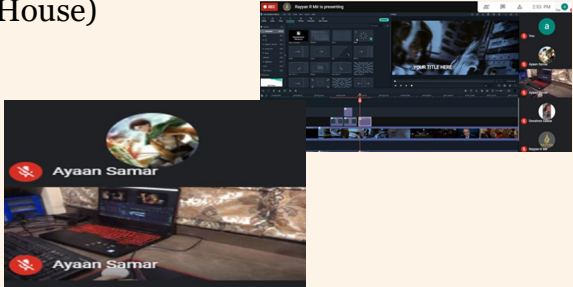


Video Editing Competition (IX To XII)

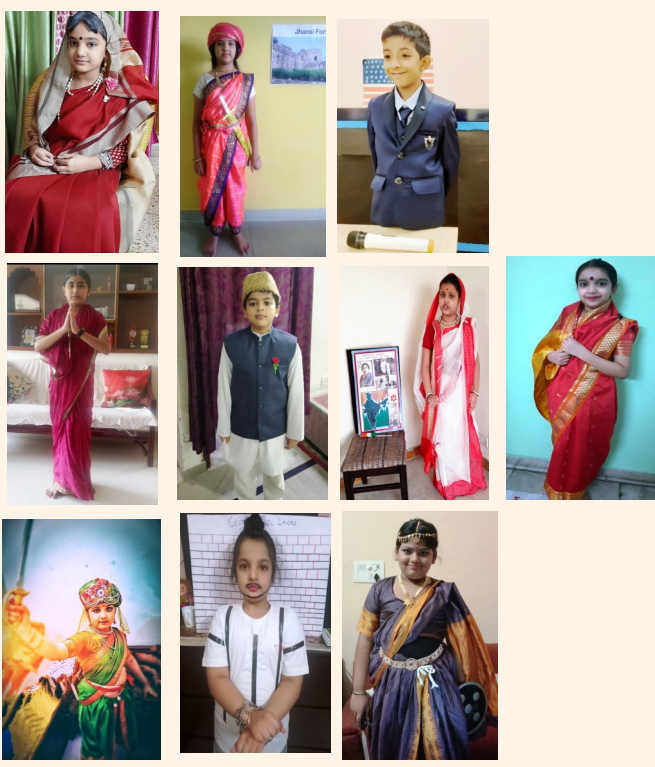

OUR FANCY DOMINION COMPETITION

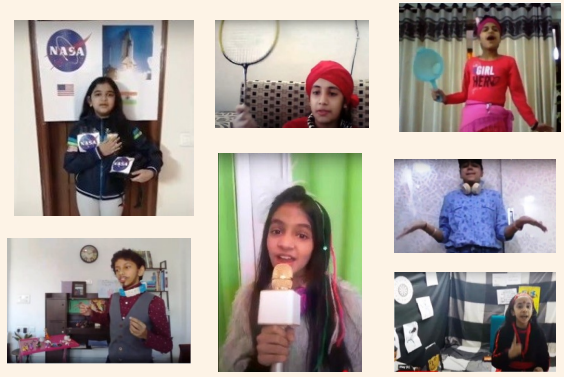

Workshop for Teachers

POCSO Workshop by Dr. Manish Arora

The Ministry of Women and Child Development introduced Protection of Children from sexual offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 in order to effectively address heinous crimes of sexual abuse and sexual exploitation of children through less ambiguous and more stringent legal provisions. This workshop aimed at empowering teachers with knowledge about personal, professional and legal aspects of teaching profession with regards to child safety. The school believes that it is pertinent that the school staff is equipped with the tools to manage crisis situation in ways that are mandated by the law.

The resource person for the session, Dr. Manish Arora is a veteran in the legal world. Dr. Arora is not just an exceptionally brilliant advocate but is also an educator, an editor, and an author. He is an advocate practicing in the Supreme Court of India, is Director, Universal Law Publishing Company and Senior Consultant LexisNexis, which are the most noted law publishers in the sub-continent. He has edited and authored number of books and edits a monthly national magazine for lawyers. He has to his credit numerous articles on legal issues published in several magazines and has also appeared on television as an expert on several occasions. On the academic front, he is on the Board of Legal Studies, Amity University. He is also a Visiting Faculty with National Judicial Academy, Bhopal and with Indian Law Institute, New Delhi. Not only that, he is also a visiting faculty with University of Queensland, Brisbane, Australia and lectures regularly at special semesters on IPR at Harvard Law School. On the judicial front, he is an Arbitrator appointed by the Ministry of Information Technology, Government of India for Settlement of International Domain Name Disputes and has also worked as Magistrate in Matrimonial matters in the XVIIth Lok Adalat at Delhi. He is Patent Agent, Government of India. He is the Director India Centre for Fast Arbitration (ICFA) Supreme Court of India. He is the past President of Harvard Club of India and presently Chairman of Legal Committee and Copyright Committee of The Federation of Publishers' and Booksellers' Associations in India.
