GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Tagfest 2020**, the Annual Inter-School Literary, Art, Drama & Technology Festival will be held on **Thursday**, **12 November 2020**.
- 2. The festival is open for the students of classes I to V.
- 3. There are **five events** in all.
- 4. Participating schools must register for at least three out of five events.
- 5. To qualify for the **Overall Trophy**, a school must participate in **all the events**.
- 6. Registration for each event should be done individually through the given Google Form. Schools are requested to register their students for the events using the given links.
- 7. Schools are required to register before **05:00 pm on Thursday**, **05 November 2020**. Any entry received after that will not be entertained.
- 8. The Google Meet link and timings of the competition for the live events will be shared with the participating schools, a day prior to the event.
- 9. Kindly ensure that students have a stable network and they join the live events using the registered email only.
- 10. Participants should be appropriately dressed for their event. The school number should be clearly pinned on the participants' lapel.
- 11. Video recording for the offline competitions should be submitted latest by **05:00 pm on Tuesday**, **10 November 2020** to the respective event In-charge.
- 12. The decision of the judges will be final and binding for all.
- 13. Results will be uploaded on the school's website and will also be mailed to the participating schools by **05:00 pm on Friday, 13 November 2020.**
- 14. The host school will participate in all events but will not compete.
- 15. Participation e-certificates will be emailed to the school.

Theme	: Classroom 2030

Guidelines:

- The participant has to make a 3D model of a 'Classroom of 2030' as perceived by her/him using papercraft.
- The model should be mounted on a half mount board of 15 inches x 20 inches dimension.
- Guidelines for recording the video :
 - The duration of the entire video should not exceed 2 minutes.
 - The participant must also announce her/ his name, class and school code within the first 30 seconds.
 - The participant should describe the model in 1 minute. The description should be in English.
 - A view showing the model clearly from all angles, including a top view of the presentation should not exceed 30 seconds.
 - The video should be submitted in MP4, 16:9 inches ratio & amp, with a good resolution. The preferred size of the file should not exceed 25 mb.

- The students must talk about the superpowers that they possess and how they can make this world a better place together.
- The recorded video should include:
 - an introduction by the participants announcing their name, class and school code within the first 30 seconds.
 - $\circ~$ the duration of the entire video should not exceed 2½ minutes.
 - the video should be submitted in MP4, 16:9 inches ratio & amp; with a good resolution. The preferred size of the file should not exceed 25 mb.

Description : This is a story writing and narration competition. Students will join the meeting and will be given instructions for the competition. Three pictures will be emailed to the participants on their registered email address. Participants have to write a story based on the pictures, scan and email the script to the event In-charge. They then will narrate the story as written by them as and when their school code is called out. Kindly note that the participants will not be allowed to change any dialogue or any part of the story while narrating.In case they do so, they will be disqualified from the competition. The story should have an element of humour which should come across clearly when it is narrated. The language used for writing and narration should be English.
