1. FILMMAKING

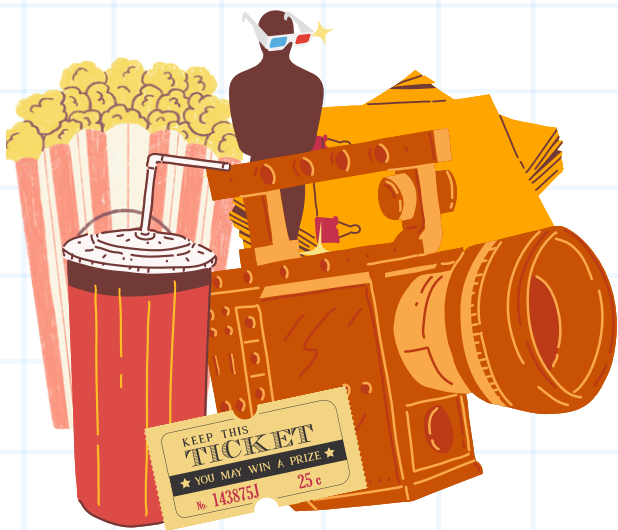

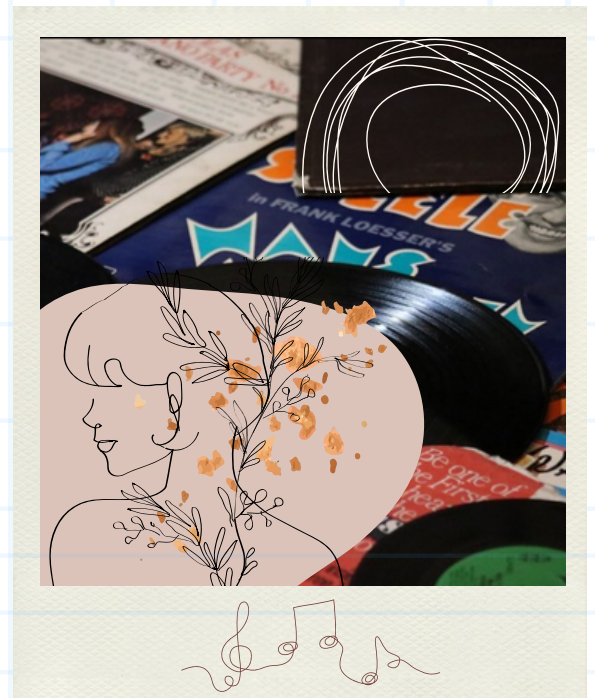
2. MUSIC ALBUM ART

3. LOGO DESIGNING

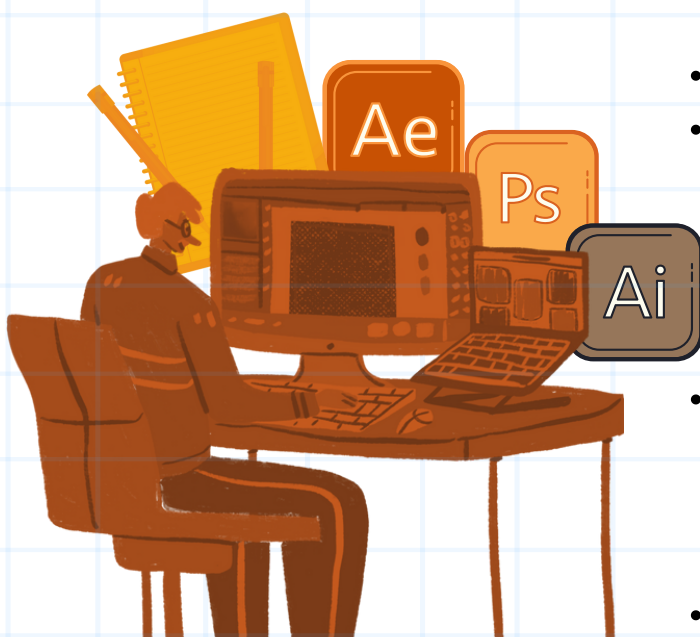

4. PHOTOGRAPHY

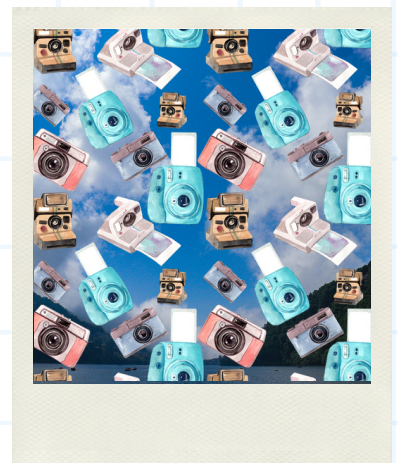

- On Saturday, 27 August, the participants will have to explain their photographs to the judges.
