Dear Parents,

As members of the Tagore family, it is re-assuring to see that unfazed by the circumstances, we all stand united in endeavoring to identify and maximize learning opportunities for our students.

On successfully adapting to digital learning at the beginning of the new academic session, we hope that your ward is now enjoying her/his well-deserved summer break.

At present, there is justifiable uncertainty about the physical re-opening of schools. Therefore, post culmination of the summer break, we will continue with online classes for students. In this challenging period of virtual schooling, we deeply value and acknowledge your feedback and suggestions.

We would like to share with you that with regard to online lessons, the school has always exercised due diligence to the age group, suitable screen time and age appropriate academic rigor. Kindly note the few pertinent changes incorporated in the schedule for classes 6 to 8:

• Increase in the number of classes from 3 to 4 lessons per day

An increase in one period per subject will facilitate the subject teacher to actively engage students in interaction and discussions during the class. In the months of April and May, this was curtailed to some degree, only due to paucity of time.

• Inclusion of 10 minutes break between each class

We are sensitive to the detrimental effects of continuous exposure of students to screen time. Therefore, between each class, we have factored in a 10 minute break for students to move away from the screen, stretch a little, drink water and eat fruits.

Integration of Co-curricular activities

Art Pursuit, Physical Education and Computer classes have been woven into the weekly schedule, to offer a school like routine.

Class-interaction time

To promote Socio-Emotional Learning, one class interaction time has been fixed per week, for students to express their feelings and interact with their peers.

Attendance

We would appreciate regularity in attending the online classes. However, once in a while, if a student has a valid reason for absence from a class, the recording of the lesson will be shared on request.

Punctuality

The students are requested to log in 10 minutes before the start of the class to avoid missing the classes for the day.
