


participated in this online competition was the same as it is always with Tagoreans.





Instrumental Music


An intra class instrumental music competition was organized for the students of classes VI-VIII. They had to submit their entry, playing either guitar or synthesizer and capture it in a video.






COMIC STRIPS DESIGNED BY STUDENTS OF CLASS V
